Residents Evacuated After Midnight Apartment Fire

State College, Pennsylvania (NBC) — Residents of a State College apartment building were evacuated for about seven hours after firefighters fought flames early Monday morning.

Firefighters were dispatched at about 12:15 a.m. by the Alpha Fire Company following the report of a fire inside an apartment at the Americana House, a seven-story building downtown.

According to the firefighters, the fire most likely started from a couch and spread inside the apartment. The fire was extinguished in about 25 minutes. No one was injured and there was very little water damage inside the building.

After the fire had been put out, State College police asked the crowd assembled outside to move away from the building. According to Police Lieutenant Greg Brauser, officials were concerned about several suspicious objects that resembled bombs found in the apartment unit where the fire originated.

After further investigation, the objects were found to be of no danger as they were part of a resident’s electrical engineering assignment. All the residents displaced were allowed to return at 7:30 a.m. by the Fire Chief.

Brauser said the exact cause of the fire has not yet been determined and a report is expected in the next several days.
